Revised Copyright Policy (Revision: December 2025)

FEIIC requires authors to assign the copyright of papers accepted for publication to the publisher. This practice is consistent with standard procedures adopted by many reputable international academic publishers and offers several important benefits.

1. Purpose of Copyright Assignment

Assigning copyright to FEIIC-IJET helps to ensure:

- International legal protection against plagiarism, infringement, and libel
- Consistent and efficient rights management, enabling FEIIC-IJET to process reproduction and republication requests in line with global copyright standards
- Broader dissemination of knowledge, by allowing the publisher to manage electronic storage, indexing, and distribution through scholarly platforms

2. Author Responsibilities

Authors are responsible for confirming that all content in the submitted manuscript may be legally published. This includes securing permission for:

- Figures, tables, or data reproduced from copyrighted sources
- Previously published material, including the authors' own earlier works
- Any proprietary or third-party content requiring authorization

If you are unsure whether permission is required, you must contact the publisher for clarification. Failure to obtain proper permission may constitute copyright infringement and could lead to legal action.

3. Scope and Effect of Copyright Assignment

By assigning copyright to FEIIC-IJET, the author grants the publisher the right to:
